In General

Shipper of hazardous goods typically distinguish between:

- Limited Quantity – Please see example for UN1263 below:
- Under exemption limits (max. 1000 points per transport)
- Above exemption limits

Furthermore we emphasize rules differ for Road/Train (ADR/RID), Sea freight (IMDG) and Air freight (IATA).




Fastlane ApS subscribe to software enabling us to write out relevant documents for sea freight and road transport. In order to write out the papers and trem cards we need the following information:

- Data sheet for the product(s) in question
- Information about how the goods are packed as to packing number of colli – see example below for UN1263.
- Brutto and netto weight per unit and for the total shipment.
